

# BADEN-WÜRTTEMBERG

Baden-Württemberg, nestled in southwest Germany and bordering France and Switzerland, is a land of captivating contrasts. From the fairy tale Black Forest to the vibrant cities of Stuttgart and Heidelberg, this region offers something for every traveler. Charming medieval towns, renowned museums, and stunning natural landscapes are perfect for hiking, exploring, or simply unwinding.

### Black Forest (Schwarzwald)




